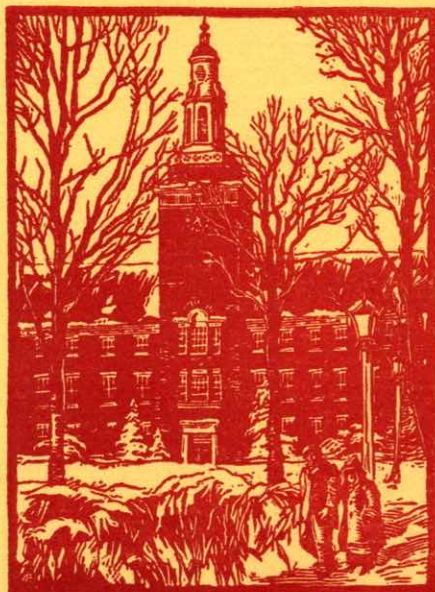

THE FACULTY RESOLUTION ON HONORS DAY
